Public Involvement/ Community Relations Plan

Purpose: To ensure that community concerns are considered in cleanup planning and execution.

- Designate Spokesperson
- Establish Administrative Record File/ Information Repository
- Explain plan for public outreach
- Public Notice of Analysis of Brownfield Cleanup Alternatives (ABCA) & Comment Period
- Response to Public Comments

Administrative Record/ Information Repository

Information that serves as basis for cleanup selection:

- Phase I & II Reports
- ABCA
- Decision Document
Response to Public Comment
- Final Cleanup Report

Analysis of Brownfield Cleanup Alternatives (“ABCA”) – or equivalent

- Extent/ sources of contamination
- Exposure pathways
- Applicable Laws/ Cleanup levels
- Analysis of Cleanup Alternatives Considered (at least two, including no action)
 - Effectiveness
 - Implementability
 - Cost
- Proposed Cleanup Plan

Decision Document

- Documents the Selected Remedy/ Cleanup Action
- Summarizes response to public comment

Quality Assurance Health and Safety Plans

- For Confirmatory Sampling

Final Cleanup Report

- Documents that cleanup levels were met & Cleanup is complete
